### Performance Notes:

In all three movements, the specific syllables used in the vocalise sections are left to the discretion of the performer.

### The Moon:

Throughout this movement, accidentals apply only to the note they immediately precede. Both voice and piano can move freely, using the written rhythms as a guideline more than a rule. The grace notes should be relaxed; at no point should the music feel rushed.

### Golden Leaves:

Starting in m. 33 and thereafter in the movement, the vocalist may choose to add embellishments within the style, either in addition to or in place of those written.

In the improvisatory section (mm 63-76) the vocalist and pianist may improvise over the given chords, repeating the section several times, as desired; the singer may sing the vocal cue line the first time and improvise thereafter, or ignore the cue line entirely, at their discretion. Alternately, the singer may choose not to improvise, and instead sing the vocal cue line, ignoring the repeat and performing the section once only.

Starting in m. 110, for ease of performance, the vocalist may improvise similar syllables, rather than adhering to those written.

#### Notes on the Text:

The intent of each poem is to capture the essence of an individual moment as a textual sketch, capturing the scenery as well as the emotional state of the speaker into a complete image. Each poem depicts a specific scene that has some significance to me.

Black Mountain is a scene viewed from a lookout point in the Black Mountains of North Carolina. The first real snow of winter blows a light dusting of snow around, and the clouds cast deep shadows across the mountains and valleys. The Moon was written during the 2016 snowstorm that dumped several feet of snow on most of the area. Looking out my kitchen window over the gently rolling snow cast in the light of the full moon, a sense of longing came over me, like a memory from another lifetime. Golden Leaves recalls a walking meditation where fall leaves fell like rain, as well as a particular maple tree whose leaves danced in the wind, casting light and shadows on each other.
